Graph Analysis of Deuteronomy 31–34

Data for Graph (NAU):

- A. Commissioning of Joshua (31:1-29) = 29 verses = 992 words* = 29%
 - 1. Moses' Counsel to Israel (31:1-13) = 13 verses = 414 words** = 12%
 - 2. Yahweh's Commands to Moses (31:14-22) = 9 verses = 360 words = 11%
 - 3. Moses' Commissioning of Joshua (31:23-29) = 7 verses = 218 words = 6%
- B. Song of Moses (31:30–32:52) = 53 verses = 1296 words = 38%
 - 1. Introduction to the Song (31:30) = 1 verse = 21 words = 1%
 - 2. The Song (32:1-43) = 43 verses = 1,028 words = 30%
 - 3. Instruction following the Song (32:44-47) = 4 verses = 105 words = 3%
 - 4. Yahweh's Instructions for Moses (32:48-52) = 5 verses = 142 words = 4%
- C. Blessing by Moses (33:1-29) = 29 verses = 771 words = 23%
 - 1. Introduction to the Blessing (33:1) = 1 verse = 20 words = 1%
 - 2. The Blessing (33:2-29) = 28 verses = 751 words = 22%
- D. Death of Moses (34:1-12) = 12 verses = 315 words = 9%

Total verses = 123

Total words = 3374 (percentages above figured on words)

*The easiest way to obtain the number of words is to paste the text into a MSWord document from a Bible program (like BibleWorks). Then remove all extraneous material like the heading saying "NAU Deuteronomy 31:1" and all verse numbers. Finally, save the document and then go to the "Tools" menu and select "Word Count."

**To obtain word count for the sections of the text, highlight the section with your cursor and then select "Word Count." Only the highlighted section will be counted.




